Article 11 – Packaging and labelling of tobacco products

In this section, you will need to provide details on the adoption and implementation of legislative or other measures on the packaging and labelling of tobacco products.

- 1) Tick 'Yes' if you have adopted and implemented legislative, executive, administrative or other measures requiring that packaging and labelling
 - Does not carry advertising or promotion
 - Does not promote a product by any means that are false, misleading or deceptive
 - Carries health warnings describing the harmful effects of tobacco use
 - Is approved by the competent national authority
 - Is clear, visible and legible
 - Is rotated
- 2) Provide information on the requirements regarding the style, size and colour of fonts in order to render the warning clear, visible and legible.
- 3) Provide information on the size of the health warnings, as is information on pictures or pictograms, their copyright and ownership.
- 4) State whether constituents and emissions are also disclosed on your tobacco products.
