## Article 5 – General obligations

In the first section, you will need to enter information on the general obligations regarding legislation, regulation and policies.

The process of data collection may involve contacting and requesting data from different government departments (ministries), units and other relevant agencies or organisations.

### Section C11

- Report, by clicking YES or NO, details on the development, adoption and implementation of comprehensive national tobacco control strategies, plans and programmes.
- Report on the establishment or support of, financially or otherwise, a focal point, unit or national coordinating mechanism for tobacco control. If you click YES to any of the questions in this part, please provide details and a brief description. Again, supplementary information can also be provided.
- Provide information regarding the protection of tobacco control policies from commercial and other interests of the tobacco industry in line with Article 5.3 of the WHO FCTC.

### Section C12

As we move to part C12, please check the YES or NO box for each of these items:

- C121 - Protecting public health policies concerning tobacco control from commercial and other vested interests of the tobacco industry?
- C122 - Ensuring that the public has access, in accordance with Article 12, to a wide range of information on tobacco industry activities relevant to the objectives of the Convention, such as in a public repository?
- C125 - Have you utilized the “guidelines for implementation of Article 5.3 of the WHO FCTC” when developing or implementing policies in this area?

For all of the above, you may voluntarily provide any additional information that you think is directly relevant to the implementation of Article 5.3 in your country.
