## Tobacco consumption and related health and social indicators –Consumption, exposure, mortality and costs

In this section, you will need to provide your country data on tobacco consumption and some related health, social and economic indicators, more specifically on consumption, exposure, mortality and costs.

### Section B1

- Fill in the information you have on the prevalence of smoking and smokeless tobacco products in the adult population disaggregated by gender and age as well as provide the exact definition you use for each category if these are different from the definitions provided in the glossary. Please note that in this section you must include the total prevalence for all forms of smoking tobacco products.
- Track the use of e-cigarettes or heat not burn tobacco products if such data is available. This information should be recorded in the open-ended questions at the end of this section on smoking tobacco products.
- Provide data on the prevalence of tobacco products (both smoking and smokeless) among ethnic groups disaggregated by gender as well as in total. Please remember to indicate the type of products included, age range and the source of these numbers.
- Report any information related to tobacco use among young persons you may have by product type, disaggregated by age group and gender, as well as in total. Please provide data on either current users or daily users only, whichever is available. Such data sources may include a recent Global Youth Tobacco Study for example.

### Section B2

Section B2 of the questionnaire covers exposure to secondhand smoke (passive smoking).

- Provide any data you have from national or regional population-based studies with regards to exposure to tobacco smoke. If any data on exposure to tobacco smoke in your population is available, please provide a detailed breakdown by gender and/or place. You also need to indicate the year and source of the data used to answer this question. The full survey reports should also be referenced in your response or provided as attachments

### Section B3

- Provide any information, regarding tobacco-related mortality in your country's population, as well as details the estimated total number of deaths attributable to tobacco use. If available, please also provide any additional information you may have on disease-specific mortality that is attributable to tobacco use, such as lung cancer or cardiovascular diseases.

### Section B4

- Report data related to the economic burden of tobacco use in your population, e.g. the overall cost of tobacco use incurred on y our country. The studies that you may use could provide details on direct (health care) and indirect costs attributable to tobacco use, as well as the method used to calculate these costs. You should also attach any supporting information as pdf files or as URL links.
