## Tobacco consumption and related health and social indicators – Supply, seizures, tobacco growing, taxation, price

This module provides details on how to report information on tobacco supply, seizures, growing, taxation and price. This information will give us an opportunity to identify trends in taxation, trade and prices of the tobacco products worldwide, and highlight good practices.

### Section B5

- Provide data on the legal supply of tobacco for three categories of tobacco products (smoking tobacco products, smokeless tobacco products and other tobacco products), as well as for tobacco leaves.
- Provide information on duty-free sales volumes and the quantity or volume of duty-free sales.

Please use the latest available data and provide additional documentation if pertinent.

### Section B6

- Provide information on seizures of illicit tobacco products. These products may include smuggled, illicitly manufactured or counterfeit products (such as smoking and smokeless tobacco products and other tobacco products). If any national data are available on the proportion of illicit tobacco products on the market, please provide this number and the source of data for this number.

### Section B7

- Identify whether there is any tobacco growing in your country. If that is the case, please provide information on the number of workers involved in tobacco growing broken down by gender, if such data are available.
- Report on the proportion of the national gross domestic product represented by tobacco leaf-growing or production. Again, remember to provide the source of these figures.

We encourage you to get in contact with other ministries or departments of your government in order to find the required data.

### Section B8

- Provide data regarding the taxation of tobacco products.
- Report any available information on the proportion of tax/retail price of a unit pack, the types of excise tax levied and the rates of taxation across different products and the trends in the taxation of tobacco products over the past three years or since submission of your last report is also requested.
- Note if any of the taxation is “earmarked” towards funding any national strategy, plan or programme in reference to Article 26 of the Convention.

Again, do not forget to provide any supplementary material you may have.

### Section 9

Provide information on tobacco prices, namely the retail prices of the three most widely sold brands of domestic and imported smoking, smokeless and other tobacco products at the most widely-used point-of-sale in the capital city of your country.
