Establishing tobacco traceability in the UK



The UK introduced the EU track and trace system in May 2019

Supplier 1

The UK appointed a supplier via open tender to act as the UK ID issuer within the EU system



The UK adopted its own track and trace system in January 2021 at the end of the Transition Period

Supplier 2

UK appointed new supplier via open tender to act as the UK ID Issuer and supplier of the UK Tobacco Track and Trace (T&T) system



The UK facts & figures

- In the UK, approximately 1.6bn unit packets of cigarettes and hand-rolling tobacco (HRT) sold each year
- Manufacturing outside of the UK
- Illicit trade impacts on the UK from both non-UK duty paid product and counterfeit product
- Over 60,000 businesses and 90,000 facilities registered in the UK T&T system
- UK supplier issues digital ID codes which are applied to products and scanned through the whole supply chain



Paying for the system

UK law establishes that manufacturers and importers are responsible for all costs of the system

- Purchasing UK UIDs from the UK supplier to be applied to each individual product
- Paying for the scanning equipment & software needed by businesses to transmit supply chain messages
- Installing Anti-Tampering Devices (ATDs) on production lines
- Purchasing security labels from their chosen security printer
- Absorbing additional supplier costs due to changes in legislation




Independence

UK has strict regulation in place to ensure that the system is independent from the tobacco industry. The UK system supplier and suppliers of ATDs & security labels must be independent in the following ways:


- Company structure

Tobacco Track & Trace System – position of UI and Security Feature




Tobacco Track and Trace – Unique Identifiers and information held in secondary repository system






Aggregate codes






Tobacco track & trace – UK Security Feature Label

Tobacco track & trace - Operational System Structure




Digital coding solution

Code pairing definition

The capacity to link a foreign code (UI) with a UK code (UI)

For imported products (e.g. produced in the EU) to not have both the EU and UK codes, the EU code is physically preserved, but digitally associated to the UK code.







Data reporting

- Registration data (Business details VAT/Excise number)
- Product type (Cigarettes, HRT etc)
- Manufacturer (Market share)
- Brand (total volumes in UK market)
- Individual product (prevalence of specific products in specific areas)
- By individual business (e.g. all products purchased by a business)
- By facility (how many of which products)
- Geographical (Prevalence of tobacco sales in a certain area/postcode)



Sanctions & Enforcement

- Compliance notices
- Suspension or deactivation of EOID
- Seizure of products
- Increasing scale of fines
- Trading Standards
- Referrals to HMRC
- Using data to proactively influence enforcement activity
